## **JUDGMENT**

- (5) The complaints of discrimination because of race based on the allegations at items (g) to (k) of the list of issues are not well-founded, and they are therefore dismissed.

(6) Since allegations (a) to (d) were dealt with previously, the overall outcome is that all of the complaints have failed.

(7) At the request of the parties, no decision about whether the Claimant or the Respondent should receive each of the deposits paid by the Claimant is made today, and will be made at a later date.
