JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is:

- 1. The Claimant's complaint that the Respondent has failed to pay her the National Minimum Wage contrary to section 1 of the National Minimum Wage Act 1998 is well founded.
- 2. The Claimant's complaint for breach of contract under the Employment Tribunals Extension of Jurisdiction (England and Wales) Order 1994 in respect of unpaid payment of wages and failure to pay the national minimum wage is well founded.
- 3. The Claimant's claim that she was subjected to detriments contrary to section 23 of the National Minimum Wage Act 1998 is well founded.
- 4. The Claimant's complaints of unfair dismissal contrary to S94 and S104A of the Employment Rights Act 1996 are well founded.

A remedy hearing shall be listed.
