JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's complaint of unauthorised deductions from the pay contrary to Part II Employment Rights Act 1996 is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's pay of £532. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of £532 deducted from pay.
- 2. The claimant's complaint of unpaid holiday pay is well founded and succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of £84.
- 3. The respondent failed in its duty to provide the claimant with a written statement of the main terms of employment complying with section 1 Employment Rights Act 1996. Pursuant to section 38 of the Employment Act 2002 the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £690 being two weeks' gross pay.
