JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant's claims for unlawful deductions from wages, holiday pay and breach of contract are well founded.
2. The Respondent must pay to the Claimant the following sums (less applicable deductions for tax and national insurance for which the Respondent must account to HM Revenue and Customs):
 - 2.1 £1,961.53 for unpaid salary;
 - 2.2 £3,675 for unpaid commission;
 - 2.3 £346.15 for unpaid holiday; and
 - 2.4 £237.60 for unpaid employer pension contributions.
