JUDGMENT

1. The claim for unpaid wages brought as a claim for breach of contract pursuant to Article 3 Employment Tribunals Extension of Jurisdiction (England and Wales) Order 1994 is not well founded and is dismissed.
2. The claim for unpaid holiday pay pursuant to regulation 16 Working Time Regulations 1998 is not well founded and is dismissed.
3. The claim for notice pay is well founded and succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of **£421.42 gross** for the period 4 January 2023 to 11 January 2023.
