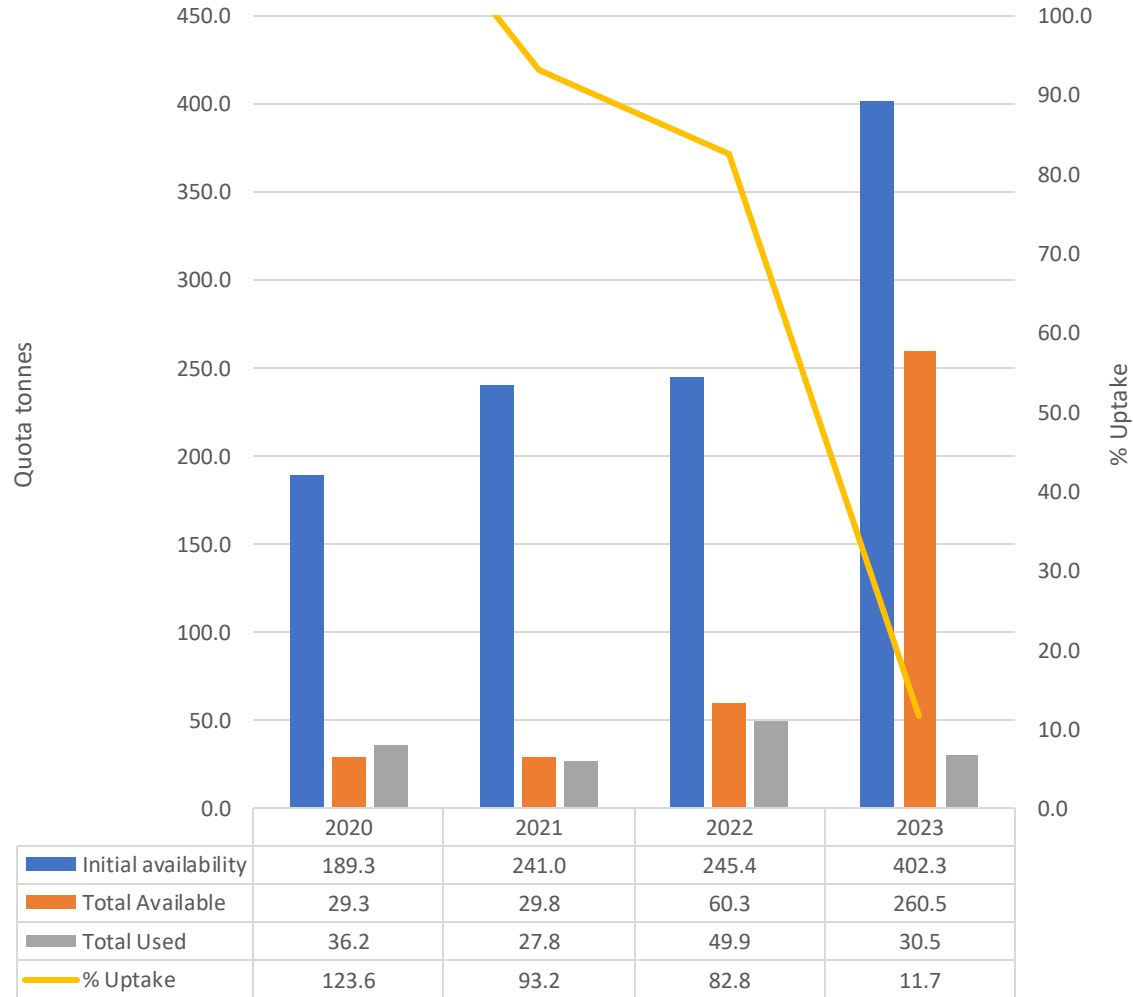

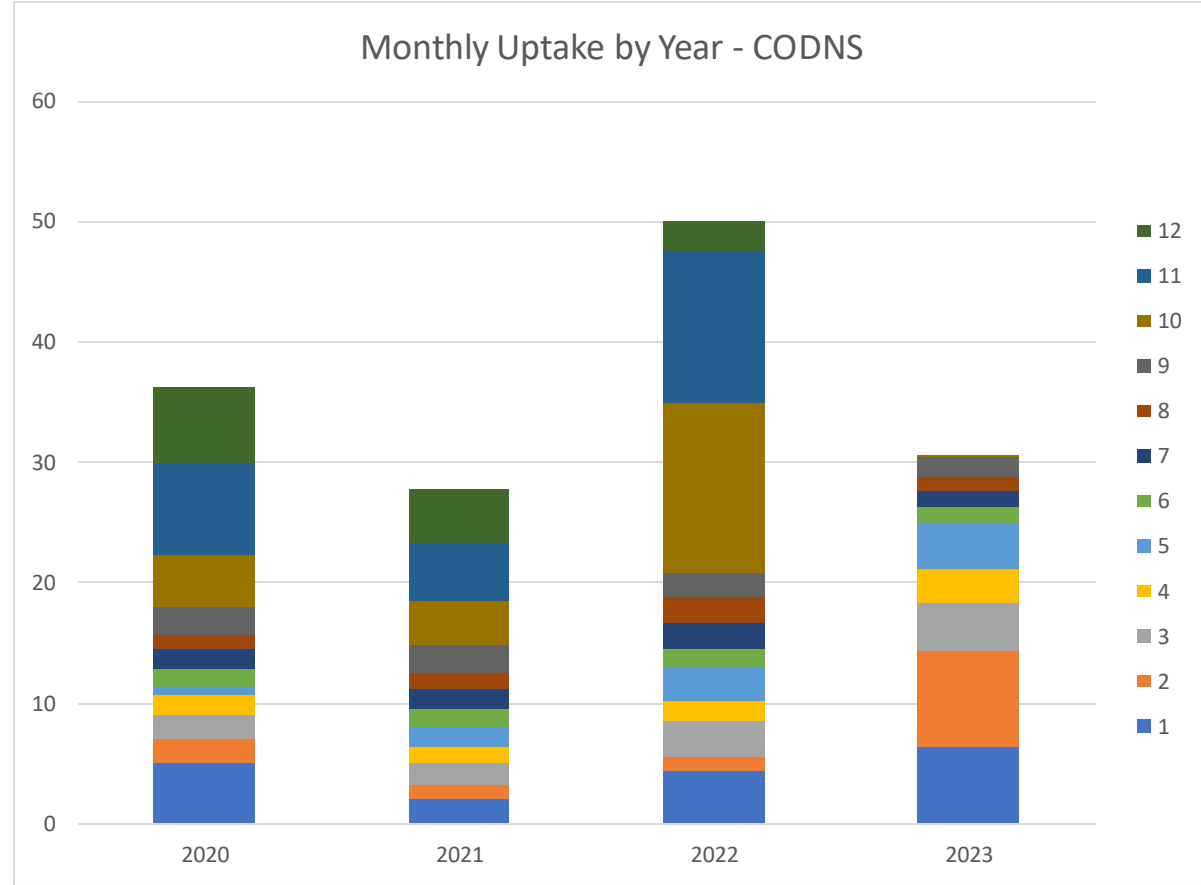


NS Cod

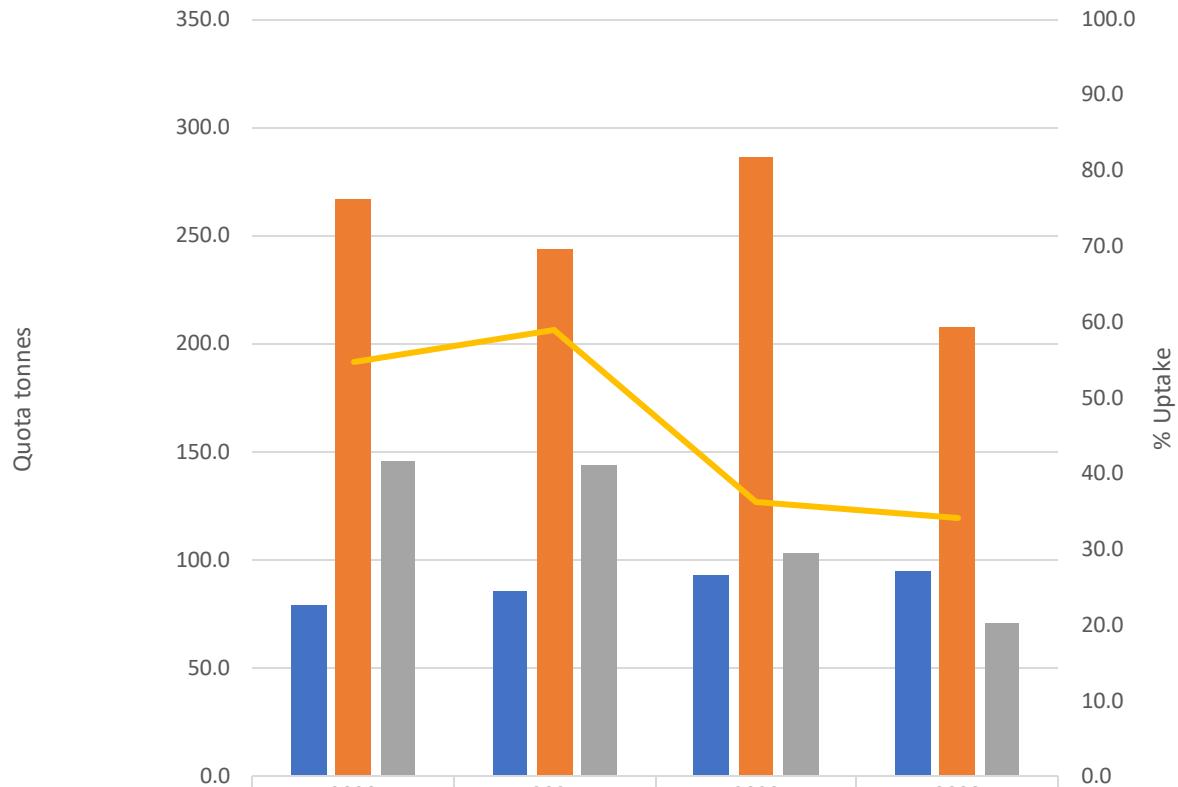

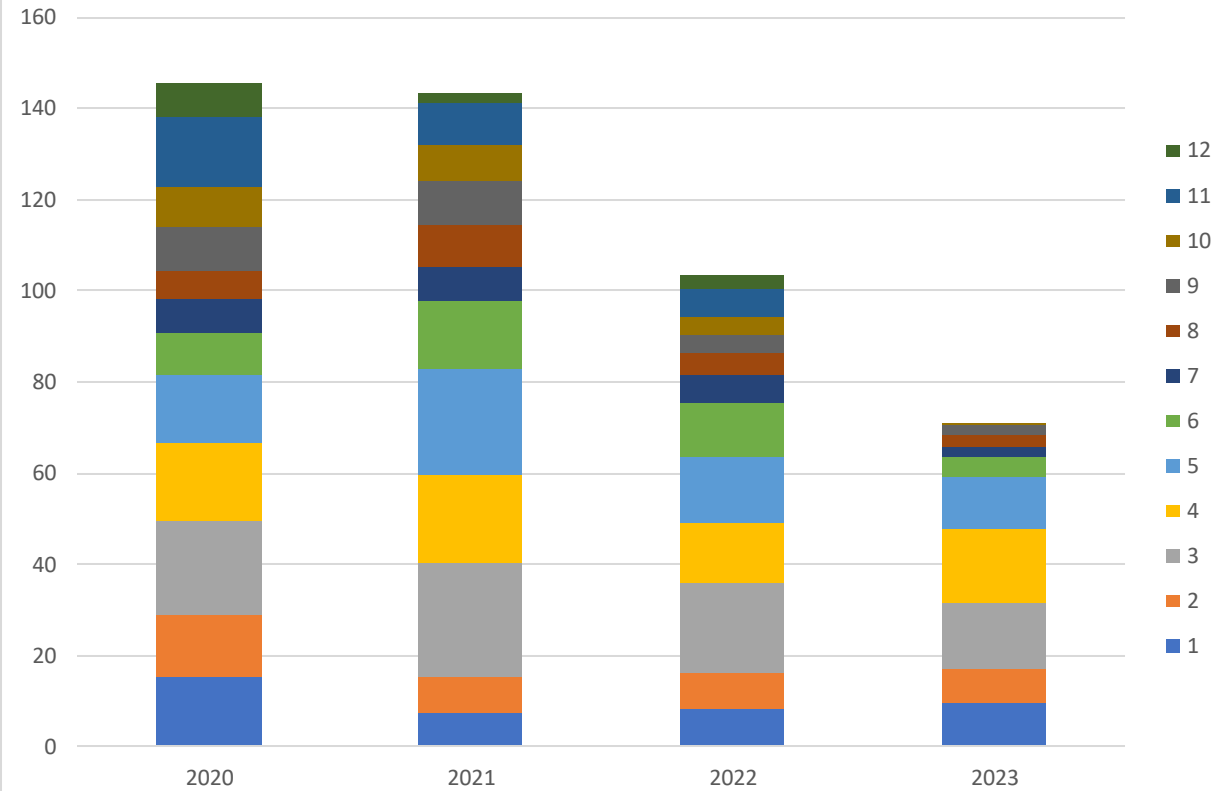

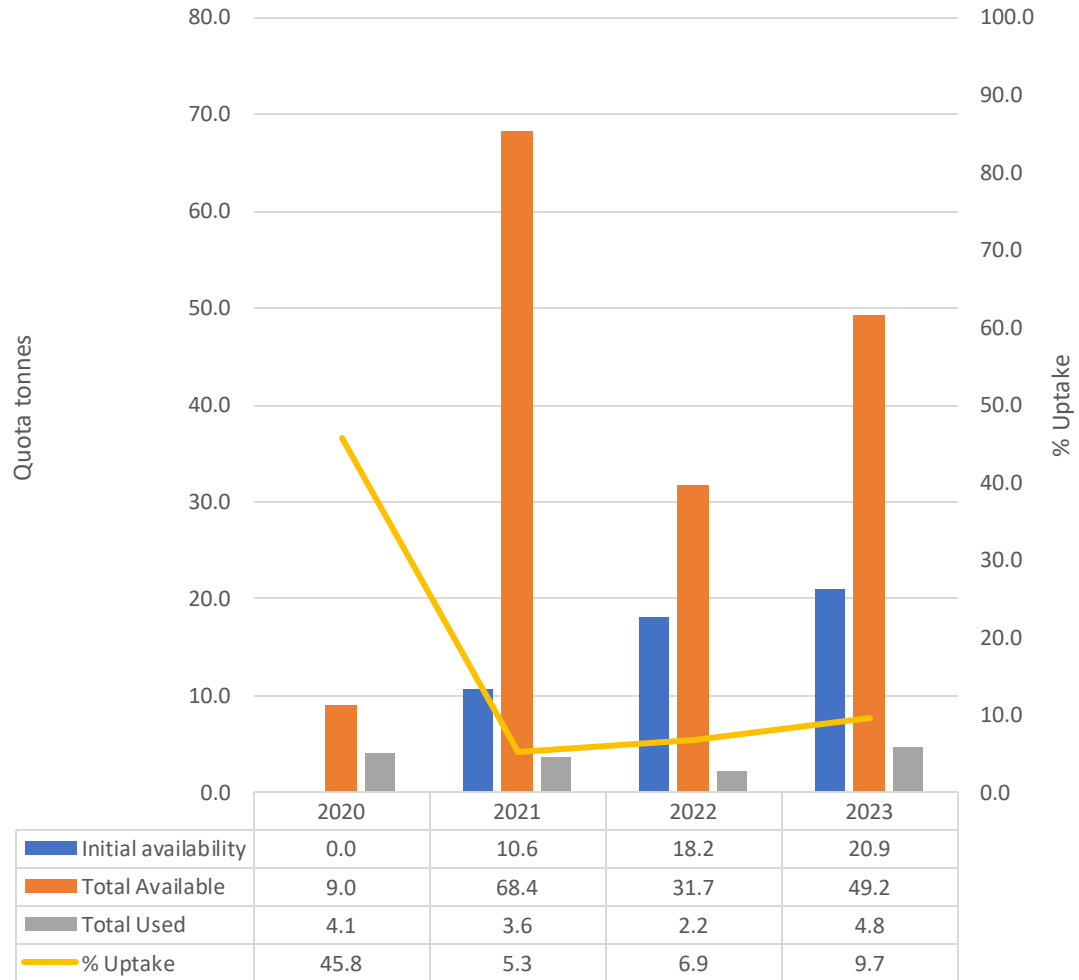

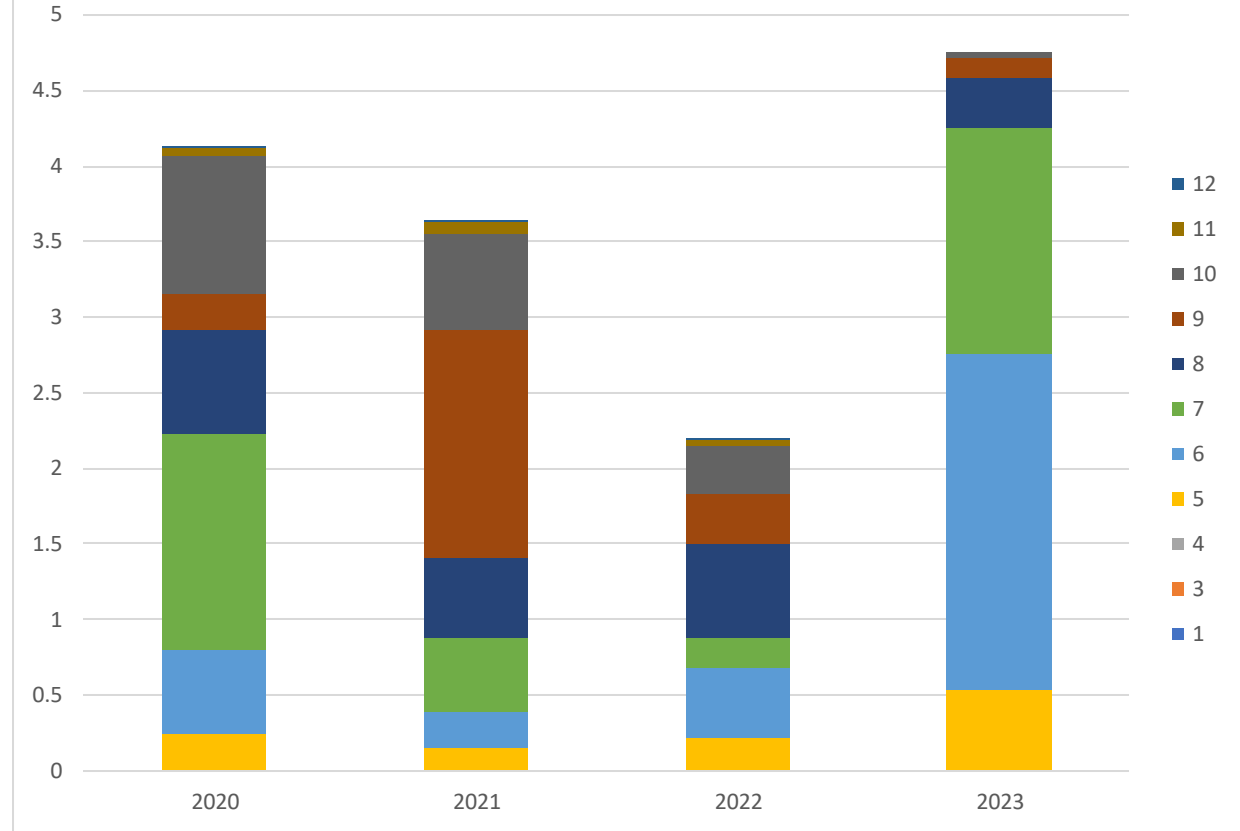

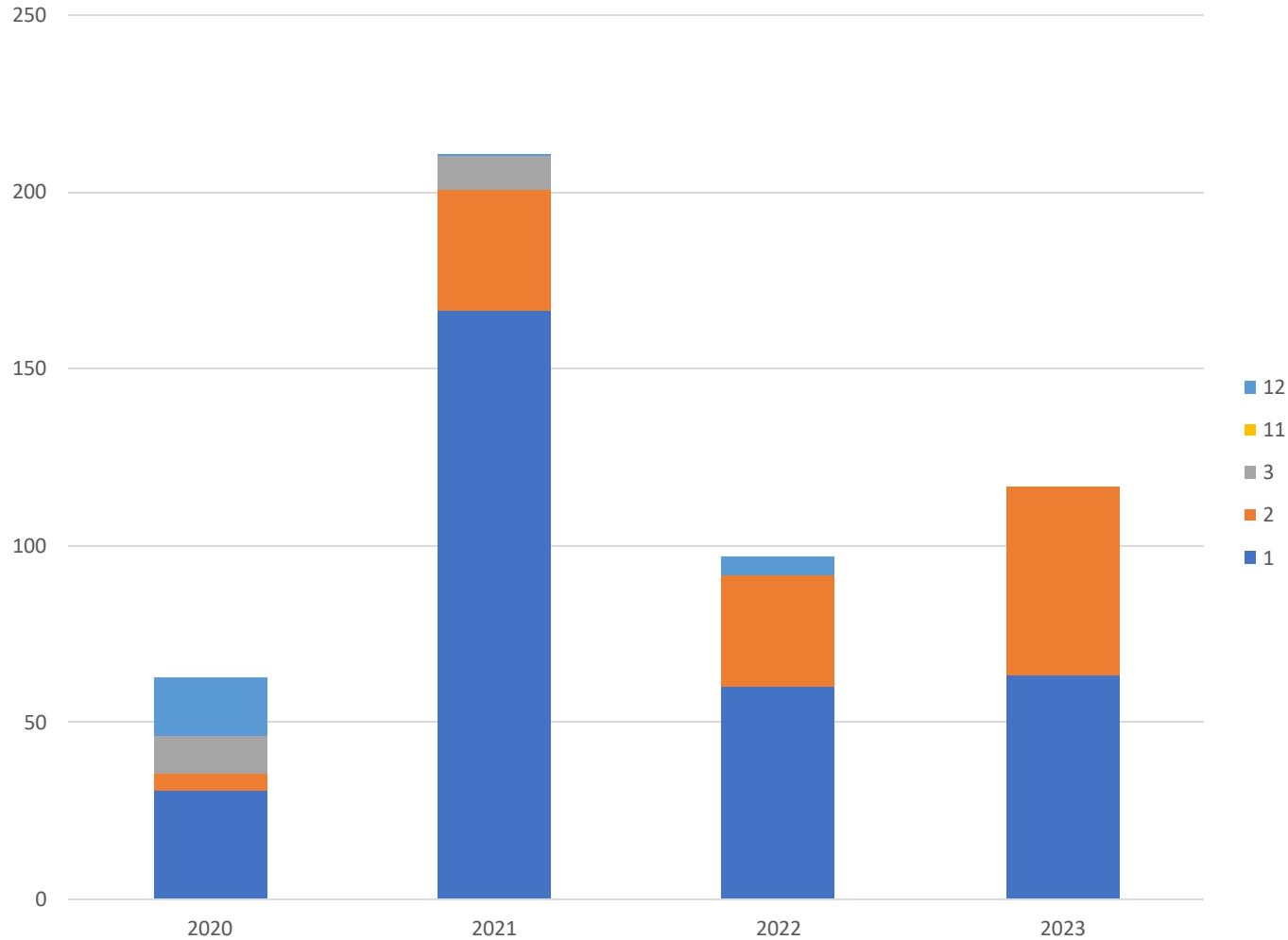

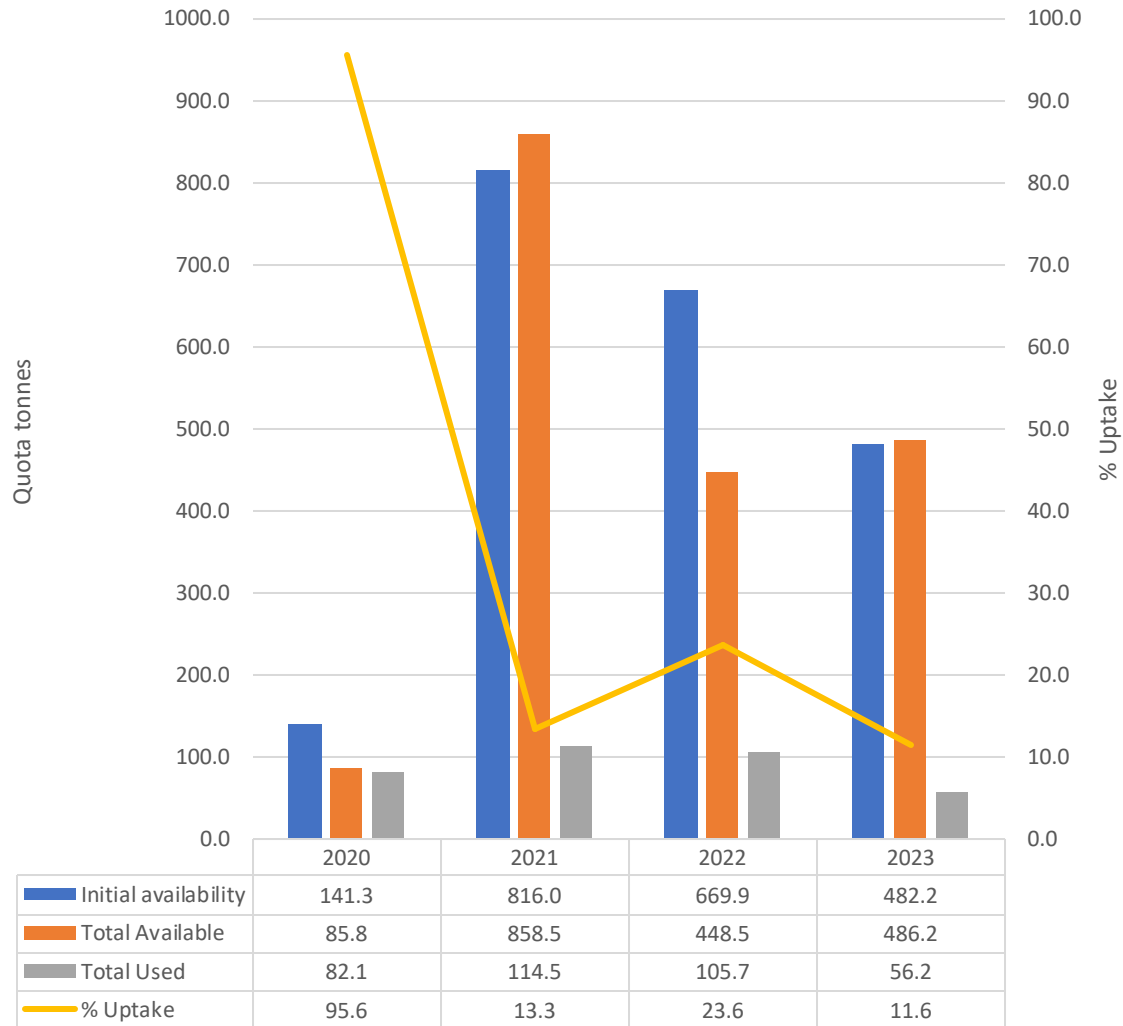

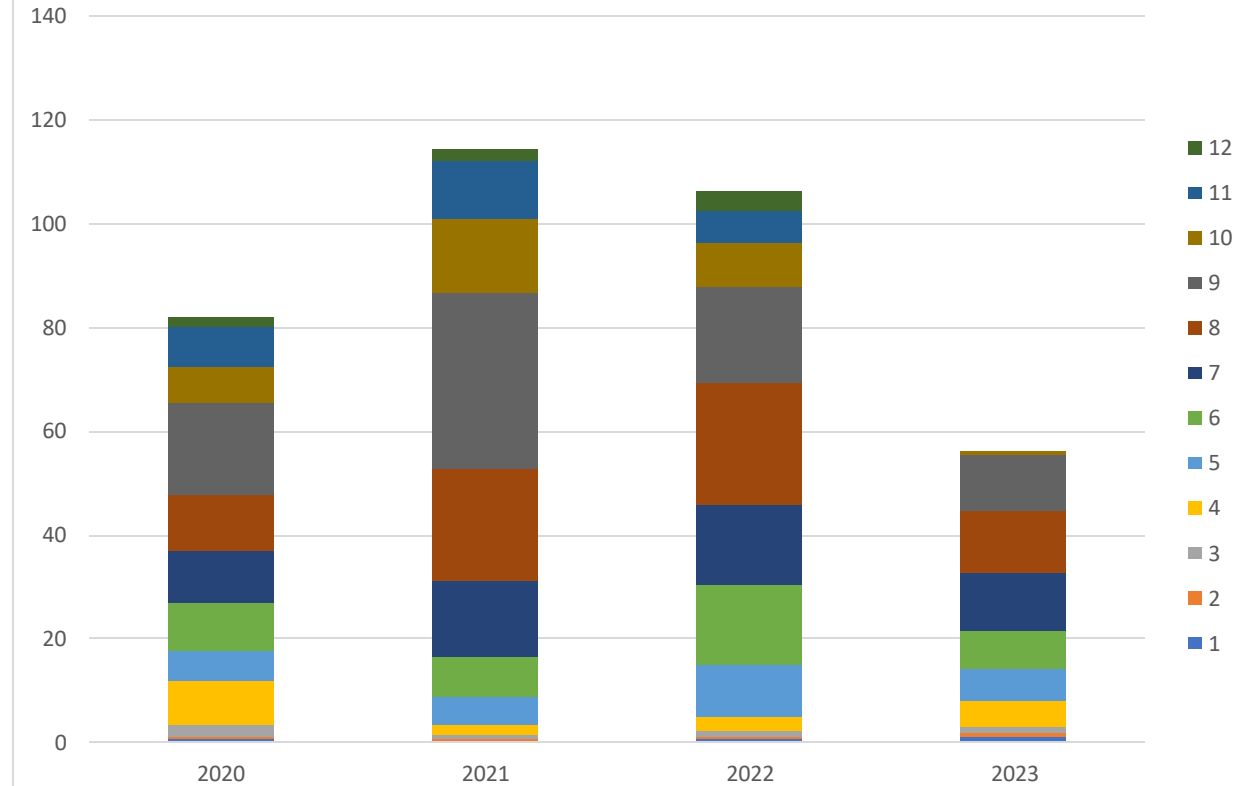

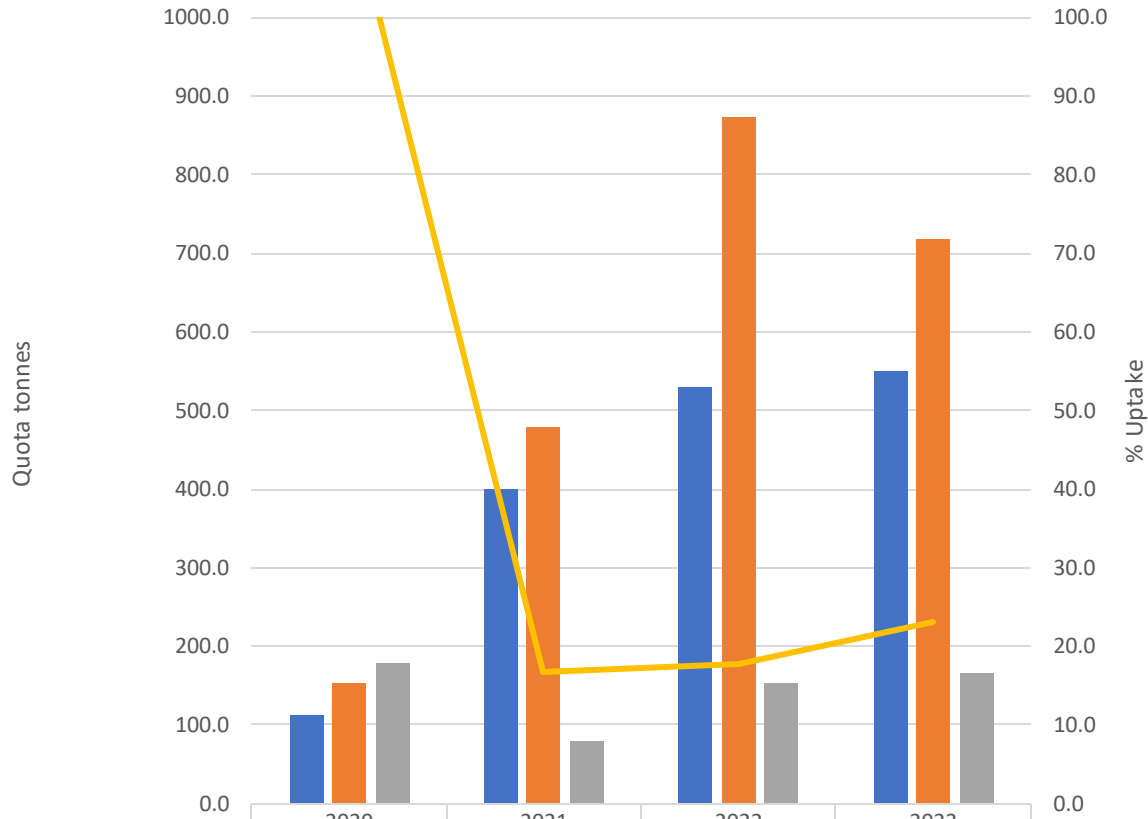

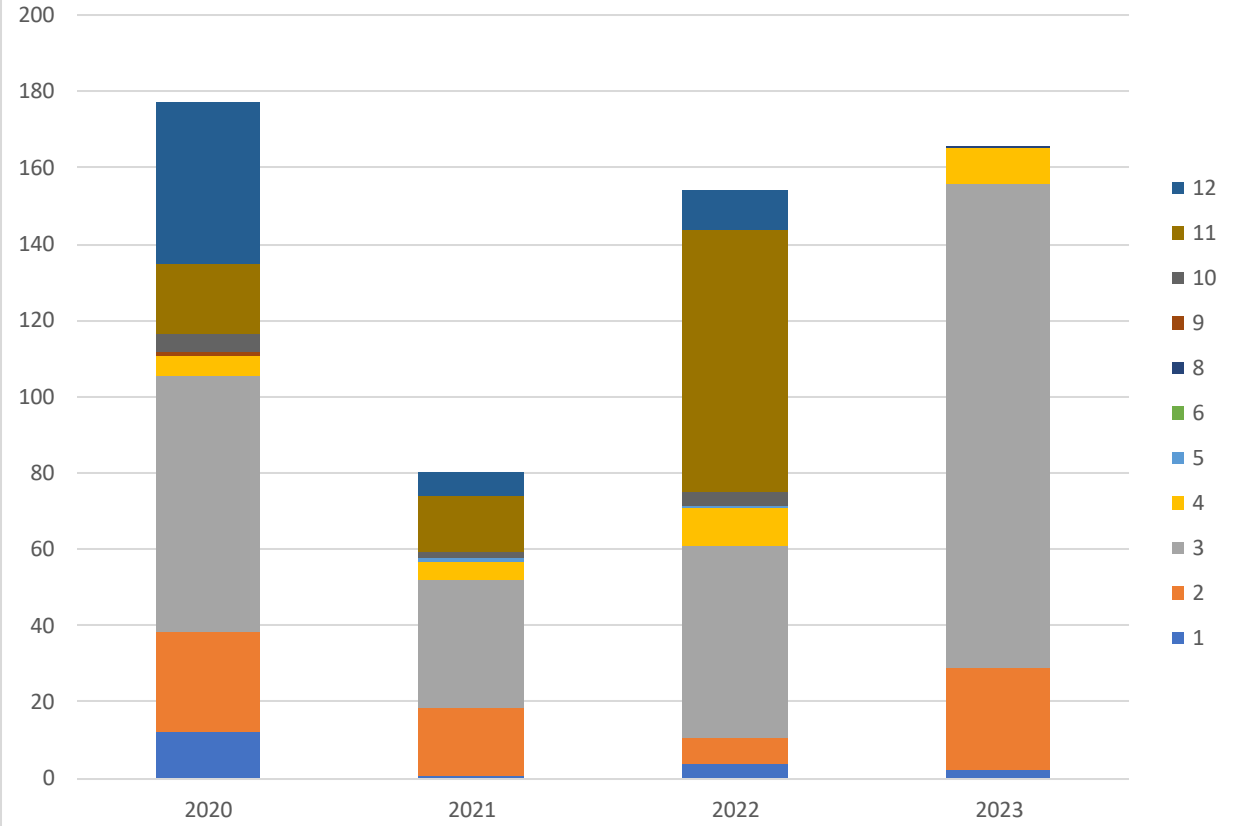
