JUDGMENT

- 1. The name of the Respondent is amended to 'Moira & Kevin Phillips trading as Penllain Garage.'
- 2. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is made out and succeeds.
- 3. The complaint of unpaid holiday pay is made out and succeeds
- 4. The Respondent must pay the Claimant the sum of £747.23, calculated as follows:

4.1.	Wages (£3298.38 - £3188.83)	104.55
4.2.	Holiday pay (accrued 1 week @ £642.68)	<u>642.68</u>
	Total	747.23

- 5. The Respondent must account to HMRC for the tax and national insurance due on the salary and holiday pay payments made to the Claimant.
- 6. The Employment Protection (Recoupment of Jobseeker's Allowance & Income Support) Regulations 1996 do not apply.
