The respondent shall pay the claimant £833.60 as damages for breach of contract (£10.42 per hour x 40 hours per week x 2 weeks) This figure has been calculated using gross pay to reflect the likelihood that the claimant will have to pay tax on it as Post Employment Notice Pay.
