PART II HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

I the undersigned Official Veterinarian of the United Kingdom, hereby certify that:

a) With regards to rabies:

*the premises of origin is within a country or region officially recognised as free from rabies during the 12 months prior to export.

*there have been no cases of rabies disease at the premise and within the radius of three (3) kilometres of the premises during past 12 months prior to export.

and

have*/have not been vaccinated against rabies.

b) With regards to bovine tuberculosis:

either

*the premises of origin is within a country or region officially recognised as free from bovine tuberculosis during the 12 months prior to export. (see attached declaration)

or

*there have been no cases of bovine tuberculosis at the premises or within the radius of three (3) kilometres of the premises during past 12 months prior to export and each animal has been tested for tuberculosis by *[chest x-rays] or *[TB skin test] during the quarantine period.
