SUMMARY MINUTES OF THE INTERIM DEVICES WORKING GROUP MEETING HELD ON 19TH APRIL 2023

Papers for advice

The IDWG considered the serious risk of unexpected loss of function, without an accompanying alarm to alert healthcare professionals and users, for a group of devices used in critical care and high dependency settings. The IDWG considered the effectiveness of the current actions to mitigate the risk and proposed further actions.

Based on the evidence, the IDWG endorsed the conclusions that the risk of using these devices outweighed any potential benefit and recommended their removal from use in the UK.

The IDWG also advised on the MHRA issuing further communication on this topic and recommended that relevant stakeholder engagement should be sought on any communications.

Procedural Items

In addition, the IDWG completed its usual procedural business including the need to observe the confidentiality of the meeting, to declare interests, apologies, announcements, approval of minutes, and updates on items previously considered. No conflicts of interest were declared.
