IV. Health information

I, the undersigned, certify that the hatching eggs described above meet the following requirements:

- a) the shells are clean, unbroken, and free from any deformity or abnormality;
- b) as far as can be determined the yolks are free from any blood or meat spots;
- c) **EITHER** *(i) The United Kingdom is free from **Newcastle disease** (ND) and **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza** (HPAI) in accordance with the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH);
 - OR** *(ii) The flock(s) of origin are in a zone which is free from **ND** and **HPAI** in poultry (poultry as defined by WOAH Animal Health Terrestrial code);
 - OR** *(iii) The flock(s) of origin are in an approved poultry compartment which is free from **ND** and **HPAI**;
- d) the hatching eggs had their surfaces sanitised in accordance with WOAH Terrestrial Animal Health Code as soon as possible after collection using an approved sanitising agent in accordance with manufacturer`s instructions:
