- The United Kingdom is free from Newcastle disease (ND) and Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in accordance with the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH);
 - The flock(s) of origin are in a zone which is free from ND and HPAI in poultry (poultry as defined by WOAH Animal Health Terrestrial code);
 - OR *(iii) The flock(s) of origin are in an approved poultry compartment which is free from ND and HPAI;
- d) the hatching eggs had their surfaces sanitised in accordance with WOAH Terrestrial Animal Health Code as soon as possible after collection using an approved sanitising agent in accordance with manufacturer`s instructions:
