JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's interim relief application is refused.

2. The Tribunal delivered an oral judgement. The respondent requested written reasons. When the Judge explained that such written reasons would be placed on the Public Register of Judgments, the claimant requested that the written reasons be subject to an anonymity order under Rule 50 of the Tribunal Procedure Rules 2013.

3. The following directions were made:

- a. the claimant should by 22 November 2023 confirm in writing to the Tribunal and the respondent whether he wishes to pursue an application under Rule 50 and if so, provide the reasons for his application in writing;**
- b. the respondent should by 29 November 2023 confirm in writing to the Tribunal and the claimant whether the Rule 50**

application is opposed and if so, provide the reasons for the opposition in writing;

- c. The Tribunal will then consider the Rule 50 application “on the papers” submitted by the parties and provide a Decision on that application and then provide the written reasons in compliance with that Decision.**

4. There is a separate Case Management Order.
