We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

Please provide the following recruitment statistics, for a 12 month period, using the most recent data you:

- 1. Number of candidates who have registered for a recruitment campaign (i.e. registered for a "pre-screen")
- 2. Number of candidates undertaking a pre-screen process
- 3. Number of candidates who were successful at pre-screen stage
- 4. Number of successful pre-screen candidares who went on to submit an application form
- 5. Number of candidates invited to interview
- 6. Number of candidates successful at interview (and able to progress to vetting/medical/fitness testing)

A search has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm we do hold information in scope of your request.

The Ministry of Defence Police most recent new recruit campaign was run between July 2022 and July 2023.
