Response

We can confirm that we do hold the requested information.

We have interpreted this request to refer to the area of land within a boundary marked by Bristol Temple Meads Station buildings to the south east, Temple Gate (A4044) to the south and south west and the water to the north, creating a triangular area of land, principally with modern office buildings.

To clarify, Homes England does own much of the land on the Temple Quay Estate, Postcode BS2 OPS.

For ease we have attached a plan which shows the land that Homes England owns within this area. Please see the attached Annex A document that accompanies this response. Homes England owns all of the land shown in both light pink and darker pink shading.
