Holiday Pay

1. The complaint in respect of holiday pay is well-founded. The respondent failing to pay the claimant 27.7 hours of holiday accrued but not taken on the date the claimant's employment ended.

2. The respondent shall pay the claimant **£263.15**. This is a gross sum. The claimant is responsible for any tax or national insurance.
