AR6 core parameters published

The Government has today published a number of documents setting out key details for Allocation Round 6 (AR6) of the Contracts for Difference (CfD) scheme. These documents are as follows:

The core parameters confirm that the Government has raised the ASP for offshore wind, as well as other technologies, and will separate offshore wind into its own pot in AR6.

The introduction of these rewards would see projects receive extra revenue support through the CfD for taking significant action to boost the sustainability of their supply chains.
