I have the following comments on the above application:

My letter of objection to the applicants previous application for 32 house is just as appropriate for this application as it was for that previous application . Please see ref UTT/22/1578/OP.

The fact that they have reduced the no of houses by 4 and rearranged them slightly makes no difference at all to my objections then which came under the headings :

- 1 Urbanisation of Clavering
- 2 Visibility of the site
- 3 out of character - all surrounding houses are linear
- 4 it is on good agricultural land
- 5 danger of access to inhabitants of Eldridge Close
- 6 use of a car as it is so far from village facilities

It was turned down in 2015 call for sites because of harm to the countryside and distance from village facilities .

It was turned down in 2022 . It should be turned down yet again , especially as Uttlesford now has a 5 year housing supply

This application is in danger of wasting the time of the planning inspector
