# How to read a criminal court register

HMCTS is in the process of rolling out a new digital case management system for criminal cases, Common Platform. This system will replace Libra and XHIBIT in due course. During the transitional period, courts will also be using the legacy systems and magistrates' courts will produce registers from both Common Platform and Libra.

This short guide is to help journalists interpret each version.

**Journalists must be accredited** and hold a **UK Press Card** issued under a scheme operated by the UK Press Card Authority to receive court registers.

#### Magistrates' or Crown Court register (Common Platform version)

The media register will be produced as a .csv file which can be opened and formatted in a spreadsheet application such as Microsoft Excel. This file will have a row for each charge a defendant faced. Similarly, each defendant in a multi-handed case will each have their own row in the .csv file.
