# 18-23 UC/JSA/ESA - The Carer's Assistance (Carer Support Payment) (Scotland) Consequential Amendments 2023

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## Introduction

 This memo gives guidance on The Carer's Assistance (Carer Support Payment) (Scotland) Regulations 2023 (Consequential Amendments) Order 2023<sup>1</sup> which came into force on 19.11.23.

# **Background**

2. This order<sup>1</sup> makes changes to social security legislation to reflect the introduction of the Carer Support Payment (CSP) which replaces CA in Scotland.

# **Social Fund Funeral Payment**

3. <u>ADM L3408</u> and <u>Appendix 1 to ADM Chapter L3</u> gives guidance on arrears of benefit payable to the deceased not being counted as assets of the deceased when considering deductions from the amount of award of funeral payment. From 19.11.23 arrears of CSP payable to the deceased as at the date of death are excluded from the assets of the deceased 1.

#### **Universal Credit**

#### The carer element

4. <u>ADM F6033</u> gives guidance that when considering whether a carer element is payable, where two or more people are regularly and substantially caring for the same severely disabled person, only one of them will be entitled to have the carer element included in the UC award. From 19.11.23 regulations <sup>1</sup> provide that where a

- 1. person (A) has an entitlement to CSP and
- 2. person (B) has an entitlement to the carer element of UC

they must jointly elect who shall have entitlement to the carer element. If there is no such election, the Secretary of State, in consultation with the Scottish Ministers, shall decide.

## Regular and substantial caring responsibilities

5. <u>ADM F6010</u> gives guidance that to qualify for an award of a carer element, the claimant must have regular and substantial caring responsibilities for a severely disabled person and would meet that condition if they satisfy the conditions for entitlement to a CA<sup>1</sup>. From 19.11.23 regulations<sup>2</sup> adds to the list

- 1. those who would be entitled to a CA but for the fact that
  - **1.1** their earnings exceed the prescribed limits **or**
  - **1.2** they are resident or treated as resident in Scotland **or**
  - **1.3** they have a genuine and sufficient link to Scotland and
- 2. those entitled to CSP.

## **Entitlement to a housing cost element – renters exempt from HCC**

6. ADM F3151 gives guidance on considering whether a renter is exempt from a HCC deduction. From

19.11.23 CSP is added to the list of relevant benefits the renter may be in receipt of to be exempt<sup>1</sup>.

#### **Unearned income**

7. CSP is taken into account as unearned income up to a maximum of the amount a claimant would receive if they had an entitlement to CA<sup>1</sup>.

## **Waiting days**

8. <u>ADM R2702</u> gives guidance on when a JSA claimant does not have to serve waiting days. From 19.11.23 CSP is added to the list of qualifying benefits<sup>1</sup>.

#### **Linked periods**

9. <u>ADM R1027</u> gives guidance on linked periods. From 19.11.23 a linked period will include when a claimant is entitled to a CSP<sup>1</sup>.

#### **Carers and remunerative work**

10. For the purpose of whether a JSA claimant is in remunerative work where they are a carer<sup>1</sup> (see R2252), CSP<sup>2</sup> is added to the list of qualifying benefits from 19.11.23. See Chapter R2 (JSA conditions of entitlement) for further details.

# **Employment and Support Allowance**

#### First contribution condition

11. <u>U1085</u> gives guidance on relaxation of the first contribution condition<sup>1</sup> where specified conditions are met, including where the ESA claimant is entitled to CA in the last complete tax year immediately before the relevant benefit year in which the first day of LCW occurred<sup>2</sup>. From 19.11.23 this includes where the claimant is entitled to CSP<sup>3</sup>.

## **Waiting days**

12. <u>U1303</u> gives guidance on when an ESA claimant does not have to serve waiting days, including where entitlement to ESA begins within 12 weeks of the end of entitlement to specified benefits<sup>1</sup>. From 19.11.23, CSP<sup>2</sup> is added to the list of qualifying benefits.

## **Universal Credit (Transitional Protections)**

#### **Amount of transitional SDP element: joint claimants**

13. Memo ADM 13/23 paragraphs 6 – 10 gives guidance on the amount of the transitional SDP element payable to joint claimants in the first AP where a person has become a carer for either of them in that  $AP^1$ . From 19.11.23 the definition of carer includes a person who is entitled to and in receipt of  $CSP^2$ .
