JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

1. The claimant's application for reconsideration dated 26 September 2023 is refused.

REASONS

1. The claimant seeks reconsideration of my decision dated 9th August 2023.
2. The application for reconsideration states that 3 harassment claims should have been heard as part of the claimant's claim.
3. The harassment claims had been struck out at an earlier preliminary hearing before Employment Judge Batten on 17 January 2022.
4. The judgment from that hearing states that the sex discrimination/harassment claims are struck out, and the claimant's remaining claim of unfair dismissal shall proceed to a hearing.
5. The application for reconsideration is therefore without merit. Having regard to Rule 72 of the Employment Tribunals (Rules of Procedure) 2013 have determined that is no reasonable prospect of the original decision being varied or revoked and the application for reconsideration is refused.
