To whom it may concern

This is the third time I have had to write about this land. It seems strange that all my comments do not get forwarded each time there is a planning application.

I disagree that houses should be built on this field for the following reasons.

It is a field. We need land to grow crops. The new houses built here were not built in a field.

The structure of Clavering is being ruined forever with infilling of houses and back filling. If these houses continue to spread there will be no separation from Stickling Green and Clavering – eroding the nature of our beautiful area.

The public footpath (if it still exists) will go through a housing estate instead of allowing country walks.

The road where houses are already built floods now – it never used to. More houses will make this worse. The road is too busy already. It is not strong enough for the amount of traffic it has now.

The shop and school are too far to walk to – people would drive. The school is full.

There is no new industry/work places – people will need to travel for work.
