JUDGMENT

- 1. The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear the complaint of unfair dismissal for the following reasons:
 - a. The Claimant was self-employed.
 - b. The Claimant had not worked for the Respondent for the minimum period of two years as required by section 108(1) Employment Rights Act 1996.
 - c. The complaint was presented on 2 August 2023, which was well outside of the time limit set by sections 111(2) and extended by 207B of the Employment Rights Act 1996, which was 29 April 2023.
 - d. It was reasonably practicable for the Claimant to have presented this complaint to the Tribunal in time.
- 2. The complaint of unfair dismissal is struck out.
- 3. The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear the complaint of unlawful deduction of wages for the following reasons:
 - a. The Claimant was self-employed.
 - b. The complaint was presented on 2 August 2023, which was outside of the time limit set by sections 23(2) and 207B of the

Employment Rights Act 1996, which was 29 April 2023.

- c. It was reasonably practicable for the Claimant to have presented this complaint to the Tribunal in time.
- 4. The complaint of unlawful deduction of wages is struck out.
- 5. The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear the Claimant's complaint of less favourable treatment on the grounds of race and disability against the Respondent for the following reasons:
 - a. The last possible date that the Claimant alleges for an act of discrimination by the Respondent is 18 November 2022. This is also her effective date of termination.
 - b. The Claimant presented her discrimination complaints to the Employment Tribunal on 2 August 2023, which was outside of the time limits set by sections 123(1)(a) and 140B of the Equality Act 2010, which was 29 April 2023.
 - c. The Tribunal does not exercise its discretion to extend time on a just and equitable basis.
- 6. The complaint of discrimination on the grounds of race and disability are struck out.
