JUDGMENT

1. The correct respondent to the claim is Duck & Champagne Limited.
2. The claim is accepted out of time as it was not reasonably practicable to present it within time.
3. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is well-founded. The respondent made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages in the period **27 January 2023 to 31 March 2023**.
4. The respondent shall pay the claimant **£2920.77**, which is the gross sum deducted. The claimant is responsible for the payment of any tax or National Insurance.
