Please complete this form in BLOCK LETTERS and in black ink.

ENSURE YOU COMPLETE THIS FORM IN FULL - FAILURE TO DO SO MAY MEAN WE WILL HAVE TO RETURN YOUR APPLICATION TO YOU, AND THIS WILL RESULT IN A DELAY TO YOUR APPLICATION BEING PROCESSED.

Enclose all documents necessary to establish your eligibility for examination for an STCW Certificate of Competency. There are document checklists on pages 3 & 4 to help you.

If eligible you will be issued with a Notice of Eligibility enabling you to sit an MCA oral examination. The Notice of Eligibility (NOE) is valid for a period of five years. The NOE will advise you how to apply for an appointment for the examination and what you should do once you have taken the examination.

Oral examination passes for each level of certification are valid for three years. The oral examination pass **must** be in date at the time of issue of the CoC.

A series of Training and Certification Guidance Notes, giving further details of requirements is available from the Seafarer Training & Certification Branch, the contact details are below or they can be found on the MCA website www.dft.gov.uk/mca.

1. PERSONAL DETAILS

Enter your personal details in the boxes provided. Your name should be given IN FULL, and should be given in the same format as appears in your passport or other National Identity document.

To check and report on how effective the MCA and the services it commissions have been. To make sure that the MCA gives value for money. We may use your information to investigate complaints, legal claims or important incidents. We may use your information for crime prevention and prosecution of offenders.

The information you provide is primarily used for issuing your UK Certificate of Competency (CoC)/Flag State Endorsement (Certificate of Equivalent Competency) (FSE) but may also be used for other related purposes, and shared with other statutory bodies/organisations to enable them to fulfil their statutory obligations.

We will not disclose any financial details you provide to us. Once your payment has been processed all financial details are securely destroyed

4. SEA SERVICE

For **all** applications the sea service declaration (page 2) **must** be completed in full.

Service should be in the deck department.

Tug service is time spent at sea, at anchor on river or canal transits and time in port associated with the work on a tug.

Watch keeping service is time spent as a Watch Keeping Officer in full charge of a navigational watch for not less than four out of every 24 hours. Shorter periods may be aggregated together.

For all sea service that is declared, you **must** submit two forms of evidence. One form of evidence can be Discharge Book entries or Certificates of Discharge, and the other form of evidence can be sea service testimonials; testimonials must be countersigned by the Master, or an authorised company representative. Testimonials need to state the sign on and sign off dates and watch keeping service undertaken.

Masters should obtain a company letter providing confirmation of their sea service signed by an authorised official within the Company. We will not accept self certified sea service.

Sea service requirements:

OOW (Tug) near coastal area:

- i 12 months as an deck apprentice with not less than 8 months on tugs or 36 months as a tug rating, including
- i. at least 90 days outside categorised waters. For a day to be counted, at least 4 hours must be outside categorised waters.
- if 'ii' is not met then your certificate will be limited to not more than 30 miles from a safe haven around the coast of the United Kingdom until relevant sea time is achieved.

Master (Tug) less than 500 GT near coastal area:

- i. 12 months serving as an officer on tugs, including
- not less than 90 days outside categorised waters. For a day to be counted, at least 4 hours bridge watch keeping duties must be outside categorised waters.
- iii. If 'ii' is not met then your certificate will be limited to not more than 30 miles from a safe haven around the coast of the United Kingdom until relevant sea time is achieved.

Master (Tug) less than 3000 GT near coastal area:

- i 24 months serving as an officer on tugs, including
- iv. not less than 90 days outside categorised waters. For a day to be counted, at least 4 hours bridge watch keeping duties must be outside categorised waters.
- if 'ii' is not met then your certificate will be limited to not more than 30 miles from a safe haven around the coast of the United Kingdom until relevant sea time is achieved.

Before a United Kingdom Certificate of Competency can be issued, you will need to submit certain documentation as specified in this section and MGN 495 (M+F).

Medical Fitness Certificates

All candidates for any CoC must produce a valid medical fitness certificate, either:

- The UK medical fitness certificate, currently known as an ENG 1, issued by a MCA approved medical practitioner; or
- A certificate issued by the Administration of any country whose medical fitness certificate is recognised as equivalent to the UK ENG 1.

Medical Fitness Certificates must be valid at the time of issue of the CoC.

All the documentation indicated in section 4 must be supplied.

4B/C - documents in these sections are required for the issue of the CoC indicated, they are not required for the issue of the NOE. If you wish to include the documents at this stage please ensure you tick (✓) the relevant boxes to indicate which documents you have enclosed with this application.
