JUDGMENT

1. The Respondent breached the Claimant's contract by not paying him commission as agreed. The Tribunal awards the Claimant the gross sum of **£3,000** by way of damages for breach of contract.
2. The Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay the Claimant the gross sum of **830.98** in respect of accrued but untaken holiday.
3. The Tribunal declares that the Claimant's complaint that the Respondent made unauthorised deductions from his wages is well-founded and the Tribunal orders the Respondent to pay the sum of **£421.98** to the Claimant in respect of the deductions.

4. The total sum awarded to the Claimant is therefore **£4,252.96** (gross).
