- 2) This revocation takes effect from 19.15 on 1 January 2024, thereby ending the measures imposed in the 10 kilometre surveillance zone centred on grid reference SX9461597889 declared on 28 December 2023 and had replaced the original declaration of a protection and surveillance zone dated 29 November 2023.
