<u>Summary</u>

Delivery Plan

The Board received a presentation on the narrative for supporting innovation as part of the draft Net Zero Research & Innovation Delivery Plan. Overall, the Board supported the narrative and the latest draft, but noted there was a need for greater emphasis on economic growth, energy security and future risk mitigation within the document.

Net Zero Buildings Deep Dive

The Board received a deep-dive presentation on the buildings sector with contributions from BEIS, DLUHC, DIT and UKRI. Overall, the Board welcomed the presentation and emphasised that the UK is in a particular climatic zone, with particular building stock, and therefore solutions need to be crafted to the UK's situation. The Board emphasised the importance of strengthening discussion and alignment between policy and R&I as they are significantly interlinked in the net zero buildings sector.

Net Zero and Green Choices

The Board received a presentation from BEIS' Net Zero Strategy team on the Government's work on net zero and green choices. Overall, the Board welcomed the presentation with departments keen to collaborate, noting the critical role of consumer research and understanding in meeting our net zero target.
