Net Zero Research & Innovation Delivery Plan

A progress update was provided on the Net Zero Research & Innovation Delivery Plan, which follows on from last year's Net Zero Research & Innovation Framework. Overall, the Board supported progress and suggested including further information on the public sector's role in addressing these R&I challenges.

Cross-HMG Enhanced Portfolio Oversight

The Secretariat outlined a proposal to strengthen the Board's strategic oversight of net zero innovation and its net zero R&D portfolio delivery capacity. The Board supported the overall proposal, whilst flagging the need to be mindful of reporting burdens on teams involved.

Hydrogen Innovation Coordination

BEIS put forward a proposal around hydrogen innovation coordination noting that the quantity of R&I and systems challenges to overcome, as well as a need for industry engagement, make this a priority. The Board supported BEIS taking this forward, ensuring that all relevant departments are engaged.
