The Secretariat provided an update on implementing the Board's feedback on the Net Zero Research & Innovation Framework provided at the last meeting. The Board agreed that this had been addressed and suggested reviewing the document's length and readability, and further developing the process and methodology sections.

Spending Review

The Board discussed the prospective Net Zero Research and Development (R&D) Spending Review bids and considered the balance of spend between research, development, and demonstration and across different sectors. Overall, the Board supported the need for a strong emphasis on Net Zero R&D at this Spending Review, with the 2020s being a key decade for innovation. The Board agreed it would be useful to discuss prioritisation around specific programmes following the high-level settlement.
