I am writing to express my objections and concerns regarding the proposed construction of new houses in Elsenham as referenced in the Subject line of this e-mail. I believe that allowing this construction to proceed would have detrimental effects for the following reasons:

- overdevelopment of green spaces
- lack of road infrastructure and access (end of Robin Hood Road is a dead end)
- detrimental effect to environment
- traffic congestion during the building phase with vehicles blocking roads and a potential safety risk to pedestrians etc
- risk to nearby property (opposite the proposed site) with flooding due to the natural springs within the land (the dead end of Robin Hood Road tends to flood a lot)

I request that you consider the objections and take necessary action to halt the construction plans. This includes a thorough reassessment of the proposed project's impact and its compliance with existing regulations.
