## JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is:

- The Claimant's complaint of direct race discrimination fails and is dismissed.
- The Claimant's complaint for accrued but untaken holiday (for 3 days (27 hours)) succeeds.

<u>By consent</u> the holiday pay amount of  $\underline{£243.54}$  (gross) is owed to the Claimant and the Respondent is ordered to pay the same.
