Dear Professor Sir Pirmohamed,  
Please accept this request under the Freedom of Information Act.

I am very concerned that MHRA are reporting over 1.5million SAR and over 2000 deaths reported via yellow card scheme. We are aware that there is a huge under reporting of yellow cards so we must expect those figures in real time to be much higher. Whilst I appreciate these figures cannot be directly attributed to the vaccine, equally without thorough and forensic investigations we will never know.

I have been in regular contact with MHRA Dame June Raine and have diligently watched every single MHRA Board meeting. I am very concerned that a simple question is not being answered, it almost seems as though I am being stonewalled. I do hope this is not the case. I was fortunate in being able to address my question to Jeremy Hunt MP when he was holding a meeting on patient safety. I am relieved that he too takes the large number of SAR very concerning too.

So my question is:  
Please can you tell me what advice you will be giving the MHRA with regard to investigating these serious, life limiting and sometimes life ending effects. Will you be recommending a thorough investigation, if not why not? Also I would appreciate your definition of 'safe'. I note the word 'safe' must never be used according to APBI. Could you explain.

As Chairman at CHM, I would appreciate reassurance that this is being taken very seriously given this is a black triangle medication still under trial.
