Requirement to correct the following inaccuracies; definition of MSFL, incorrect use of speed to categorize Helicopters and the use of RVR for the commencement and continuation of approach.

- Following a request by the RC, additional guidance on RNAV departures has been provided.
- Throughout the MMATM, additional information that could only be found in Battlespace Management Orders but which affected all of the RC has been incorporated.
- -Contents of RA 3294 Reporting of Hazardous Flying Conditions is now held within Chapter 2 of the MMATM, facilitating the withdrawal of RA 3294 as it was not deemed to be regulatory material.
- Chapter 5 Emergency Procedures has been updated to include F-35 Flameout Procedures and correct inaccuracies within the Hawk SIFL and SIPFL procedure.
- Ther terms Executive Control and Operational Control for the Types of Emergency Control have been retained but are currently under review, they will be updated in a future amendment.
- Chapter 6 Establishment, Disestablishment or Changes to Airspace has been updated to correct out of date information
