What does the rule relate to?	Rule / change	Live example (before and after)
Textual data - Financial charges	Where the interest rate and/or value of the financial charge was missing, the charge now shows 0 as amount and/or rate of interest.	<p>Before: 549</p> <p>After: 0</p>
Textual data - Addresses	Addresses have been populated for all charges.	<p>Before: Some charges would only have a default holding address or no address.</p> <p>After: All charges have an address or a geographic description of the affected land.</p>
Textual data – Missing/Invalid dates	The correct registration dates have been populated for all charges.	<p>Before: Some charges would have a missing or invalid registration date.</p> <p>After: All charges have the correct registration date populated.</p>
Textual data – Personally Identifiable Data	Where personally identifiable data was found in the supplementary information, this has now been removed.	<p>Before: Some charges would have a telephone number or email address for a customer.</p> <p>After: This data has been removed to adhere to General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) protocols.</p>
Textual data – Part 6 charges	Any expired part 6 charges are removed.	<p>Before: 99</p> <p>After: 0</p>
Textual data – Part 3 charge creation date before 01/08/1977	Planning consents prior to 01/08/1977 are removed.	<p>Before: 1557</p> <p>After: 0</p>



Spatial data	All charges contain an appropriate geometry.	Before: Not all charges had a geometry or had invalid geometry. After: All charges have an appropriate representation of the charge extent.
Textual data - Charge types and sub-categories	All charges in the Register now contain a charge type and a sub-category in accordance with the HMLR schema.	Before: Inconsistencies in charge-types, sub-categories, instruments, and statutory provisions found. After: Charge type mapping successfully applied to all charges where applicable in accordance with the HMLR schema to show relevant charge-types, sub-categories etc.
