This is one of the worst development applications I have ever seen, so will probably be approved! It looks like someone has found a field and said "let's build a 50 houses estate here". But we must move the bus stop. I have never seen so much verbal diarrhoea, the Landscape and Visual Appraisal has 36 pages. Some firm called Lichfields spend 33 pages on the 5 year housing supply review, basically full of meaningless statistics that are not supported by facts.
