# JUDGMENT

## Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

1. The claim was issued in the Bristol Employment Tribunals on 4 April 2023. The Respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
2. The Claimant's claim that the Respondent made unauthorised deductions from wages is well founded. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of **£1,666.67** (gross).
3. The Claimant's claim for accrued but unpaid holiday pay is not well founded and is dismissed.
