## JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

- 1. The claim was issued in the Bristol Employment Tribunals on 4 April 2023. The Respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The Claimant's claim that the Respondent made unauthorised deductions from wages is well founded. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of **£1,666.67** (gross).
- 3. The Claimant's claim for accrued but unpaid holiday pay is not well founded and is dismissed.
