UPON the application by the Appellant for permission to appeal the decision of GEMA to, among other things, modify licences to introduce a common minimum

capital requirement for gas and electricity suppliers ('the **Decision**');¹

AND UPON the CMA granting the Appellant permission to appeal the Decision;

AND UPON the CMA granting OVO and EDFE permission to intervene in the appeal in respect of grounds 1 and 3;

AND UPON the CMA considering the grounds of appeal and the representations and submissions of the parties and the Interveners;

AND UPON the CMA issuing its reasoned determination in these proceedings on 19 January 2024 (the 'Final Determination')
