<u>Judgment</u>

- The Claimant was not employed in the UK at the time of the matters giving rise to his claim. The Tribunal cannot therefore deal with his claims of unfair dismissal and unlawful deductions from wages under ss98 and 13 Employment Rights Act 1996 as those rights did not apply to him.
- 2. The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to deal with the Claimant's claim of breach of contract because the Claimant was not an employee at the time his employment was terminated as required by Article 3 of the Employment Tribunals (Extension of Jurisdiction) Order 1994.
- 3. The Claimant's claims are therefore dismissed.
