Converter Academy Orders

Points discussed in relation to school conversion.

Project: Discussion to consider the proposal of a new MAT called Ambition Community Trust to be formed and for the following schools to convert and join the trust:

- Tameside Pupil Referral Service, Tameside.
- Russell Scott Primary School, Tameside.
- Greswell Primary School and Nursery, Tameside.
- Corrie Primary School, Tameside.
- Millbrook Primary School, Tameside

AB discussion:

- The board supported the project recommendation with one condition.
- The board reflected that this was a sensible proposal and is in line with the published trust development statement for Tameside.
- The board reflected that the trust board would benefit from recruiting trustees who are not involved in the five schools, to bring an independent voice.
- The board noted the trust's long term strategy to grow beyond Tameside.

1. Trust to provide the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) with a trust level 3-year financial plan.
