Thank you for your correspondence of the 18 October 2023 requesting the following information:

I have seen a previous request for eyesight requirements for all roles and it just stated for some of them 'Adequate corrected vision is required'. Does this mean there is no longer a limit of +6 and -6 with the prescription and as long as your eyesight with glasses is good, you'd still be eligible, the role in question here is 'Aircraft Technician (Mechanical)'.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). A search for the information has now been completed, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

The visual requirements for Aircraft Technician (Mechanical) are:

Uncorrected vision <6/60 in each eye separately.

Corrected vision 6/9 or better in each eye separately.

Under Section 16 (Advice and Assistance), you may find it useful to know that for General Service the refraction limits are: -6.00 Diopters Spheres (DS) to +5.00DS. Maximum Cylinder (Max Cyl) +/- 3.00 Diopters Cylinder (DC).

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact us in the first instance at the address above. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail: cio-foi@mod.uk). Please note that any reason for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal process has been completed.
