IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned, certify that the hatching eggs described above meet the following requirements:

- a) During the 90 days prior to export the flocks of origin of the hatching eggs to be exported were:
 - i. as far as it has been possible to determine, not exposed to highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) or Newcastle disease (avian paramyxovirus-1);
 - ii. not in any country, region or zone established because of the detection of Newcastle disease or HPAI in commercial poultry;
 - iii. inspected on the premises of origin prior to movement of the eggs for export and were found to be clinically free of signs of communicable diseases of poultry;
- b) on (date), being within 30 days prior to the date of shipment, fresh environmental samples were collected at random within the shed in which the flock(s) of origin were housed and were tested bacteriologically for the presence of Salmonella enteritidis at a laboratory approved under a national control programme for salmonella implementing European Council Regulation 2160/2003, and the samples gave a negative result in every case and there was no evidence or knowledge of Salmonella enteritidis present in the flock;
- c)* (delete in the case of hatching eggs from turkeys) within 90 days prior to the date of export at least 5 percent, or a minimum of 150 birds in each flock of origin were tested for egg drop syndrome (EDS, or adenovírus 127) with negative results in each case;

 within the previous 90 days for Avian Metapneumovirus [also known as
 Turkey Rhinotracheitis (TRT), Avian Rhinotracheitis, or Swollen

 methods:*rRT-PCR,or *ELISA, or *serology. The flock(s) or origin
 *are/are not vaccinated against this disease;
- e) The flocks of origin have not been vaccinated against subtypes H5 of H7 or any other subtype of **avian influenza**;
- f) EITHER (i)* the flocks of origin have been vaccinated against Newcastle disease (avian paramyxovirus) at least 21 days prior to export, using vaccines that do not contain any velogenic strains of Newcastle disease

The hatching eggs have been cleaned and sanitized as soon as possible after collection using an approved-for-use sanitizing agent in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Hatching eggs have been packed in clean or appropriately sanitized shipping materials.
