Management scheme charges	Prior to migration North Herts had 10 management scheme charges where the corresponding supplementary had two sets of registration dates within one single registration. It was agreed as part of the migration that these would be split up in to separate registrations therefore creating 10 new charges.	Before: Management scheme charges revealed would give information on both registrations in one. After: Management scheme charges give separate information across two registrations. supplementary information Length	Where supplementary information for some charges exceeded 1500 characters. The LA authority reviewed and updated these charges to fit withing the limit	Before: full text exceeding the 1500 character limit After: full description of charge now refined by North Herts to fit the limit
CDO - Charge creation & registration dates	The charge creation date and registration date for some of the combined drainage orders were presenting as pre 1925 dates, however correct dates were found in the supplementary information and therefore the dates were changed to correctly show.	E.g. Before: 'Combined Drainage Orders appear to have been conceived in pre-1937 public health legislation Registered date:30.09.1937 Charge creation date: 13/02/1907 Charge registration date: 13/02/1907 After Charge creation date: 30/09/1937 Charge registration date: 30/09/1937
