

Babies and young children can be strangled by looped blind cords and chains. Keep them safe by:

Securing cords and chains out of reach with a suitable safety device fixed to an adjacent surface. Cords can be wound in a figure of eight around a special hook called a cleat. A tensioner or tidy will hold a looped cord or chain permanently taut
