1. INTRODUCTION, MINUTES, AND ACTION TRACKER

- 1.1 The Chair welcomed members and attendees to the meeting.
- 1.2 There were no new or changed conflicts of interest and the minutes and action tracker of the previous meeting were approved.

2. FUTURE AGILITY OF THE EDUCATION SYSTEM

- 2.1 The Board received an update of the Department's work and understanding of the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and technology in education and the associated challenges and opportunities presented.
- 2.2 Board members discussed examples of good practice in the use of AI in the education sector and means of improving the sector's technological capability.
- 2.3 Board members were encouraged to promote the call for evidence for the use of AI in schools, colleges, and other education settings.

3. SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

- 3.1 The Board received an update on the Department's work to improve attendance in schools.
- 3.2 Board members noted the barriers to reducing the number of persistent absences in schools and the challenges that existed pre-COVID-19 which contributed to these.
- 3.3 Board members discussed the role of the Department in the use of comms to schools, local authorities, parents, and learners.

4. TERMLY STRATEGIC REVIEW

- 4.1 The Board was provided with an update on the most recent Termly Strategic Review, a stocktake on the Department's medium-term priorities and trends.
- 4.2 Board members discussed the delivery challenges facing the Department's priorities.
- 4.3 Board members discussed challenges to the social worker and teacher workforces, noting the wider trends in the labour market.
