1. INTRODUCTION, MINUTES, AND ACTION TRACKER

- 1.1 The Chair welcomed members and attendees to the meeting.
- 1.2 There were no new or changed conflicts of interest and the minutes and action tracker of the previous meeting were approved.

2. EDUCATION RECOVERY

- 2.1 The Board received an update on the most recent Key Stage 2 results and what these demonstrated in terms of education recovery since the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 2.2 The Board discussed the challenges facing education recovery and the important role that Local Authorities, Multi-Academy Trusts, and school leaders play in education recovery. Members discussed the National Tutoring Programme and its impact on education recovery.

3. SCHOOL BUILDING RISK

- 3.1 The Board received an update on the impact of Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC) in school buildings, following the Department becoming aware of the three cases of RAAC in schools over the 2023 summer holidays.
- 3.2 Board members discussed the short and long-term impacts of RAAC on the education sector and the responses across government to RAAC.
- 3.3 Members noted the fast pace of the Department to respond to RAAC and thanked colleagues for their hard work.

4. FINANCE UPDATE

- 4.1 The Board was provided with an update on the Department's financial position at P4 and the Autumn Statement.
- 4.2 Board members discussed further education following the Office for National Statistics' reclassification of colleges into the public sector.
- 4.3 Board members noted the important role of employers in Further Education to help establish strong links between colleges and industry.

5. PERFORMANCE UPDATE

5.1 The Board was provided with an overview of departmental performance against the Secretary of State's priorities, including numbers on attainment relating to education recovery.

5.2 Board members discussed the delivery of reforms to childcare and social care workforce, in addition to the delivery of T Levels.

6.1 The Board was provided with an overview of the 2023 Board Effectiveness Evaluation. The Board, Audit and Risk Committee, and Nominations Committee are reviewed annually to assess the effectiveness of their arrangements.
