

Statistical release

The latest provisional monthly energy production, trade, consumption and prices statistics produced by the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero were released on 25 January 2024.

Energy production, trade and consumption statistics are provided in total and by fuel and provide an analysis of the latest 3 months data compared to the same period a year earlier. Energy price statistics cover domestic price indices, prices of road fuels and petroleum products and comparisons of international road fuel prices.

Energy production, trade and consumption

Highlights for the 3-month period September to November 2023, compared to the same period a year earlier include:

- **Primary energy consumption in the UK on a fuel input basis fell by 1.0%, with higher energy and other prices a key factor in reduced consumption levels. On a temperature adjusted basis consumption fell by 3.4%. ([table ET 1.2](#))**
- **Indigenous energy production fell by 9.4%, due to falls in all fuels except coal, bioenergy & waste, solar and hydro. ([table ET 1.1](#))**
- **Electricity generation by Major Power Producers down 13% with coal up 27%, but gas down 25%, renewables down 5.4% and nuclear down 1.0%.* ([table ET 5.4](#))**
- **Renewables provided 44.0% of electricity generation by Major Power Producers, with gas at 36.7%, nuclear at 16.4% and coal at 2.1%.* ([table ET 5.4](#))**
- **Low carbon share of electricity generation by Major Power Producers up 5.3 percentage points at 60.4%, whilst fossil fuel share down 5.3 percentage points at 39.0%.* ([table ET 5.4](#))**

Highlights for January 2024 compared to December 2023:

- **Petrol down 4.3 pence per litre and diesel down 4.0 pence per litre. ([table QEP 4.1.1](#))**

Statistics on monthly production, trade and consumption of coal, electricity, gas, oil and total energy include data for the UK for the period up to the end of November 2023.

Statistics on average temperatures, heating degree days, wind speeds, sun hours and rainfall include data for the UK for the period up to the end of December 2023.

Statistics on energy prices include retail price data for the UK for December 2023, and petrol & diesel data for January 2024, with EU comparative data for December 2023.
