Thank you for your report, received on 23 January, which provided a comprehensive analysis of the Tees Valley Combined Authority's oversight of the South Tees Development Corporation and Teesworks Joint Venture. I would like to thank you for your rigor and dedication in undertaking this work.

I am pleased that you found no evidence of unlawfulness or corruption. You have, of course, raised some important points on governance and oversight of the joint venture which I take seriously. I have asked the Mayor to consider these carefully and provide me an initial response on how he intends to address these points by 8 March. I also note the recommendations you have made to the Government, which we will carefully consider and respond in due course.

The regeneration in this area represents a unique and transformative opportunity, which your report notes, and has had a real effect already on jobs and aspiration locally. The importance of this opportunity only further emphasises the need to get the processes that deliver it right.
