## JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

On hearing for the Claimant by video and with no ET3 or attendance from the Respondent:

- 1. The Claim for unlawful deduction of wages succeeds. The Respondent is ordered to pay the gross sum of £1,519.23 to the Claimant for unauthorised deductions of wages. The Claimant is requested to account for any tax to HMRC as appropriate.
- 2. The Claim for breach of contract succeeds. The Respondent is ordered to pay £211.15 to the Claimant for unpaid expenses outstanding upon termination of the Claimant's employment with the Respondent.

### EMPLOYMENT JUDGE SMART 08/01/2024

The reasons for this decision were given orally at a hearing. Written reasons will not be provided unless they have been requested in writing by any of the parties within 14 days of the date this judgment was sent to the parties.
